The truth is that 60% of women in the armed forces report being sexually harassed throughout their terms.

And if you look around the world -wherever the U.S. Military has bases- brothels and the global sex trade surround them. But in the resistance movement, young women everywhere are taking the lead and fighting side by side with their brothers.

Which side will you stand on?

Will you side with the slave masters **OR** the slaves who rebelled?

Will you side with the US cavalry **OR** with the American Indian warriors?

Will you side with the brutal police **OR** the fearless protesters in the streets?

Will you side with King George II **OR** the 6 billion people of the world?

G.I.s who said no:

During the Vietnam War, thousands of GIs, many of them Black, refused to fight the Vietnamese people who were defending their country against the U.S. invasion.

•Mohammed Ali was drafted and he refused to go, saying, "No Vietnamese ever called me nigger." Carl Dix of the Fort Lewis 6 spent two years in Leavenworth Prison for refusing to go to Vietnam.

•Jeff Paterson, a marine corporal, was the first to resist the 1991 Gulf War. He refused to board the plane to the Persian Gulf. The antiwar movement took up his case and fought for his freedom. Hundreds more followed his lead and refused to go.

•The Call to Conscience is a statement by hundreds of veterans and resisters who have called upon today's soldiers to do the right thing and act on their conscience. Check it out: www.calltoconscience.net

Now is a time for heroes, when ordinary people must take extraordinary action. Think about it, and do what you know is right. Don't let them bully or intimidate you. *Take a stand now!*

J-ROTC is present in over 2800 high schools nationally. Students in Santa Cruz, San Francisco, Philadelphia, and elsewhere have held actions to shut down the Army Recruiters on their campus. It's time for students everywhere to take back the campuses from the military and send a message: We Won't Fight Your Unjust War! We won't be bullied, lied to, or suckered into the military.

With George Bush's *No Child Left Behind Act* any school that receives federal funding is expected to turn over confidential information about its students to the military recruiters. It should really be called "*No Child Left Unrecruited!*"

At Bushwick Outreach, a high school in Brooklyn, the administration and student body refused to comply with the Act and did not turn over any information to the government.

They want our names, addresses, grades, and phone numbers. Rally up and tell the recruiters and administrators that you want off the list!

If you want to be a part of something bigger than yourself...

If you want to change the course of history and build the power of the people, if you want to live your life like the heroes you respect, then do the right thing and build resistance to stop the war and repression.

George Bush won't write history but we will! Now is our time, the time for our generation to take the stage of history and make our voices heard.

To the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marines: We ain't going out like that! We won't have the blood of innocent people on our hands. Not by our hands and NOT IN OUR NAME!

We Won't Be the Cops of the World!


This flyer is part of the national *Stop The Military Recruiters Campaign of NOT IN OUR NAME*.
