- Use firm statements
- > Assume support
- > Inflect the voice down
- Use strong word choices

Conversational Style

- > Lots of open ended questions
- Natural voice inflections
- Listen and respond

Concision

- Clear and simple message
- > To the point
- No extraneous information or facts

Specific Amounts

- Set parameters for contributing
- > Start high, drop slowly
- Be flexible as needed

Charges

- > Ask confidently
- Use rebuttals as needed
